
Singing Voice of a Beagle

Medicare and Obamacare

In June I wrote to Senator Casey, Senator Fetterman and Congressman Reschenthaler about protecting Social Security and Medicare. I never heard from Fetterman, Senator Casey's responses are always the same but Congressman Reschenthaler told me something I did not know. In his one paragraph he starts off with "As you may know". No I did not know, did you? Obama and Biden should never have touched Medicare to pay for this health care program. Property Tax Reform –A letter I sent to my State Representative on July 1, 2024

Where is the property tax reform we have been promised so many years ago? I just got my Canon-Mac tax bill for 2024 and they raised the school taxes again. The extra \$130 you gave to homeowners in my salary range for the property tax/rent rebate program doesn't even cover the amount my school taxes were increased too. So where is making the lives of property owners better with this so called "huge" rebate increase when you must use that extra rebate to pay for the increase in school taxes? You politicians promised voters property tax reform just to get elected. It is about time you step up and live up to that promise before more seniors lose their homes to sheriff sales. Even Senator Bartolotta stated in her newsletters about making Pennsylvania a better place to live for seniors. It's about time you made it happen.

Letter to Senator Bartolotta on June 21, 2024

I am asking that you please move HB1210 out of your committee so that the full state Senate can vote on it.

HB1210 is a crucial bill allowing judges to include companion animals in Protection From Abuse orders (PFAs) in Pennsylvania. As your constituent, I believe it is our responsibility to speak out against any form of abuse, including the use of animals as a means of control and harm.

Currently, Pennsylvania is one of the only states that does not allow judges to include animals in PFAs. This leaves many victims of domestic violence in the difficult position of having to choose between their safety and the well-being of their pets. Seventy-five percent of abused women with pets report a history of their companion animal being threatened or intentionally harmed by their intimate partner, often with children present and witnessing the violence over 90% of the time.

HB1210 passed out of the PA House in the summer of 2023 but has been sitting in your Committee since then. This bill must move forward to provide muchneeded protection for both human and animal victims of domestic violence.

By supporting HB1210, you will make a significant difference in the lives of animals and ensure that Pennsylvania does not lag behind other states in protecting survivors of domestic violence and their pets. Please listen to the voice of your constituents and take decisive action to pass HB1210. Thank you!

HB2139 Live Pigeon Shoots—Letter to my State Representative Jason Ortitay

On June 24th I sent a letter to my State Representative Jason Ortitay about a Facebook post asking everyone to help get HB2139 passed. This is why:

URGENT: Help end cruel pigeon shoots in Pennsylvania! Live pigeon shoots are barbaric contests where live birds who have been captured, often illegally from neighboring states, are shot at close range. Shooters earn points for each bird they hit, causing unnecessary suffering, often leaving many wounded rather than killed outright.

Despite the availability of challenging clay shoots, Pennsylvania remains the one of the last states where these notoriously cruel events are regularly held.

Please contact your state representative TODAY and ask them to pass HB 2139 to finally outlaw these barbaric contests in Pennsylvania.

I told Ortitay that our government should be ashamed of themselves to allow this cruelty to take place. I never received a response from him on this letter or the letter I sent to him on July 1st on Property Tax Reform. Ortitay is up for re-election in November. I think he has over stayed his welcome and is lacking on his duties. I will be voting for the other candidate this coming election. Hopefully he will do better. Update on The Keystone's Post on Pennsylvania's Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program. They updated their Facebook post to include widows and widowers over 50. Nice to know that someone finally listened to me. It is sad though that this tax cut is being called the largest in nearly two decades. Your salary range determines the amount you get. For many, that dollar amount came to \$130.00. The maximum dollar amount is \$350.00 which is for those making under \$8000.00. After nearly two decades of no changes to this program, Shapiro could have done better.
