I found your page on a distant friends page, and it's brought me comfort this last week and half since my husband died. I'm finding it hard not to be angry when none of our friends and very little of the family has reached out to me in any way. My spouse's brothers and sisters are getting tons of condolences, flowers, cards and I don't even get a 'sorry for your loss' if it wasn't for my children I would be entirely alone through this. I'm really hurt and trying not to be bothered by this, but I can't help it. He fought cancer the last four years, and I was his sole caregiver and worked two jobs to support us. None of the friends or relatives helped out, but now its like they are clambering for the spotlight, and I feel almost like they are stealing my grief. Is this common? Am I in the wrong for feeling angry and resentful towards our friends and community?

Sorry for your loss. What you're going through seems common. You are grieving deeply and I feel others can't understand your pain and don't know how to react. No one understands until it happens to them.










Memorial Service For Our Passed Pets
